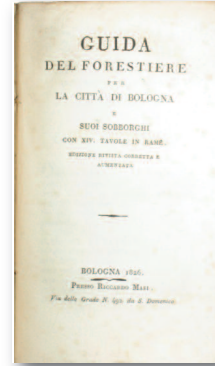

50.5 x 68 cm. Large decorative folding plan of Florence, copper engraved on thick paper. Folds between between original "tree calf" paper covers, with manuscript title label to upper board. Uncoloured. Oval panel to upper right corner featuring the fleur-de-lys emblem of the city, Allegorical illustration to the bottom left corner, featuring a reclining male figure accompanied by a lion with city in the background. Both the plan and the covers in excellent condition.

The plan was originally designed by Ferdinando Ruggieri and published in Zocchi's famous work "Scelta di XXIV vedute delle principali contrade, piazze, chiese, e palazzi della città di Firenze". This a very good quality re-issue of that map with some minor modifications to the decorative aspects of the plan.

**RUGA, Pietro.**

Pianta Della Città di Roma con la Indicazione di tutte le Antichità e Nuovi Abbellimenti. Rome: Venanzio Monaldini. 1827 [F42676]

74.5 x 111.5 cm. Large folding engraved plan of Rome, uncoloured. The whole dissected into 32 sections and mounted on linen, folds into original "tree calf" covered slipcase. Mapseller's printed label to upper board with old ink annotations, old ink inscription to case just above label. Sixteen vignette views of Rome to the sides of the plan. Some very light wear to the extremities of the case, otherwise in excellent condition.
